All selections (except sonatas with piano) must be presented from memory.

REPRESENTATIVE REPERTOIRE (For pre-screening and live auditions)

Solo works by:

- Handel
- Eccles
- Dittersdorf
- Bach (cello suites)
- Dragonetti
- Koussevitzky
- Bottesini

All selections (except sonatas with piano) must be presented from memory.

Graduate MM & DMA Applicants

PRE-SCREENING INSTRUCTIONS

Video recordings are mandatory and must be unedited.

- One movement of Bach cello suite
- Two contrasting movements from a standard concerto
- Three orchestral excerpts

LIVE AUDITION

- A complete concerto, chosen from the following list. This work should be performed from memory.
 - Koussevitzky
 - Dragonetti
 - Bottesini
 - Dittersdorf
 - Vanhal

If you wish to play a concerto that is not on this list, the request should be submitted at least 30 days prior to the audition.

- Two contrasting movements from a Bach unaccompanied suite.
- A virtuoso piece or complete sonata
- A selection of at least three contrasting orchestral excerpts

All selections (except sonatas with piano) must be presented from memory.
